The following non-refundable application fee is payable for each programme you apply for:

Please note that an application without the application fee payment or with

insufficient application fee amount will not be processed.

3. **The following supporting documents as indicated below need to be uploaded in the graduate admission system (GDA2) for the processing of the application by the deadline, 15 November 2023:**

- a) An official/copy of Bachelor Degree Transcript (with English translation if applicable)
- b) A certified copy of Bachelor Degree Certificate/Scroll (with English translation if applicable)
- c) An official/ copy of Masters Degree Transcript (if applicable) (with English translation if applicable)
- d) A certified copy of Masters Degree Certificate/Scroll (if applicable) (with English translation if applicable)
- e) Copies of TOEFL/IELTS score sheets **for applicants whose native tongue or medium of undergraduate instruction is not English.**

The minimum score ranges requirement for TOEFL score is:

Paper-Based Test: 580-600,

Computer-Based Test: 237-250,

Internet-Based Test: 85

The minimum score requirement for IELTS is 6 and above.

Please note that the TOEFL/IELTS scores are valid for 2 years from the test date. If it has been more than two years since you last took the test, you must take it again to have the scores reported.

- f) Copy of GRE score report (**All PhD candidates are required to submit GRE score report with effect from August 2023 intake**)

For GRE, the applicants must attain an aggregate minimum score of **320** is set for the **GRE Verbal (V) and Quantitative (Q)** sections and a minimum score of **3.5** is set for the **Analytical (A)** section

Please note that the GRE scores are valid for 5 years from the test date. If it has been more than five years since you last took the test, you must take it again to have the scores reported.

- g) Two Referee Reports

The referee reports will directly be sending to your referees by e-mail to complete the online referee reports after the online submission of the application.

- h) Professional Certificates, if any;

- i) A copy of citizenship certificate/national identification card (Pink) **for Singapore Citizens** OR

A copy of identification card (Blue)/Re-Entry Permit **for Singapore Permanent Residents (PRs)** OR

A copy of passport page/Identification Card showing nationality and personal details/ Work Pass (For example: Employment Pass, S-Pass) (if applicable) for **International Applicants**

- j) Documentary evidence of financial support (e.g. bank statement, or letter of confirmation from a sponsor, or documentary evidence of scholarship or other awards obtained or salary statement for last three months) (**Only applicable for the self-finance applicants and those who want to consider their application if their scholarship application is unsuccessful**).

5. Applicants must produce originals of all documents when requested if admitted to the programme.
