Tuition Fees Structure for AY2025 intake

Local students (Singapore Citizens/Singapore Permanent Residents)

Starting from AY2023/2024, all Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents, enrolling into MSc Statistics programme will be automatically extended with a 15% tuition fee rebate.

- Acceptance Fee (after 9% GST): S\$5,450 (one-time payment upon offer acceptance)
- Students are required to read and pass five core courses (including ST5188), and five elective courses.
- Full-time and part-time local students will be billed based on the number of courses read per semester (pay by per-course fee).
- Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents who enrolled to the SSG-funded courses which are skills-based and industry-relevant may be eligible to receive up to 70% subsidy. For Singapore Citizens aged 40 years old and above, the subsidy may be up to 90%.

Full-time and part-time students who read more than 10 courses OR obtain a 'F' or 'CU' grade and need to repeat/replace the course will need to pay the additional course by per-course fee.
